1. MEDICARE OVERVIEW FOR OREGON (UPDATED 3-11-21)

Oregon Medicare enrollment was about 892,000 in 2019, with just over 422,000 enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan. About 13% of the state's total Medicare populations is comprised of individuals with disabilities. Oregon wasn't involved in a dual demonstration. However, the state had over 24,000 SNP members as of November 2020.

2. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN FINANCIALS

Medicare Advantage plans in Oregon generated total premiums of \$3.7 billion in 2018 and medical costs of \$3.3 billion. Average MLR was 89.4% before reinsurance recoveries.

(Note: Financial metrics and comparisons presented in this overview are based on health plan NAIC filings in the state. Measures like per member per month premiums and medical loss ratios may vary greatly by plan and by state depending on the mix of business and other factors.)

4. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN PREMIUMS, DEDUCTIBLES, STAR RATINGS

Oregon's top five Medicare Advantage plans had STAR ratings of 3.5 to 4.5 in 2020. Maximum premium ranged from \$72 per month at UnitedHealth Group to \$196 at Providence Health & Services.

5. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE ENROLLMENT UPDATE

There were about 892,000 Medicare members in Oregon in 2020, up 2.0% from 2019. Traditional Medicare accounted for more than half of the total at 52.7%; however, its share is declining. Medicare Advantage enrollment accounted for 47.3% of the total at about 422,000, a 6.2% increase in 2020 compared to year-end 2019. Excluding Prescription Drug Plan and 800 Series enrollment, Medicare Advantage members rose 7.2% to 363,997 in 2020.

UnitedHealth Group is the largest Medicare Advantage plan in the state, followed by Cambia Health Solutions and Kaiser Foundation Health Plan.

6. SNPs and Dual Eligibles

Oregon had a total of 24,496 Special Needs Plan members as of November 2020, of which 22,523 were dual eligibles. CareOregon and Atrio Health Plan own over 70% of the market, with 52.7% and 22.2%, respectively. The state wasn't involved in a dual demonstration.
