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1. MEDICARE OVERVIEW FOR TENNESSEE (UPDATED 3-12-21)

Tennessee Medicare enrollment was about 1.4 million in 2019, with just over 594,000 enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan. About 18% of the state's total Medicare populations is comprised of individuals with disabilities. Tennessee wasn't involved in a dual demonstration. However, the state had just over 121,000 Special Needs Plan members as of November 2020.

2. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN FINANCIALS

Medicare Advantage plans in Tennessee generated total premiums of \$6.7 billion in 2019 and medical costs of \$5.5 billion. Average MLR was 82.1% after reinsurance recoveries.

(Note: Financial metrics and comparisons presented in this overview are based on health plan NAIC filings in the state. Measures like per member per month premiums and medical loss ratios may vary greatly by plan and by state depending on the mix of business and other factors.)

4. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN PREMIUMS, DEDUCTIBLES, STAR RATINGS

Tennessee's top five Medicare Advantage plans had STAR ratings of 3.5 to 5.0 in 2019. Maximum premium ranged from \$31 per month at Anthem, Inc. to \$221 at Blue Cross Blue Shield of Tennessee.

5. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE ENROLLMENT UPDATE

There were nearly 1.4 million Medicare members in Tennessee in 2020, up 1.5% from 2019. Traditional Medicare accounted for more than half of the total at 57.2%; however, its share is declining. Medicare Advantage enrollment accounted for 42.8% of the total at just over 594,000 in 2020, an 8.0% increase compared to year-end 2019. Excluding Prescription Drug Plan and 800 Series enrollment, Medicare Advantage members rose 8.4% to 550,962 in 2020.

Blue Cross Blue Shield of Tennessee is the largest Medicare Advantage plan in the state, followed by Humana and UnitedHealth Group.

6. SNPs and Dual Eligibles

Tennessee had 121,495 SNP members as of November 2020. Plans that contract with the state for Medicaid are required to offer DSNPs to the dual eligible population on a statewide basis. UnitedHealth Group is the largest health plan, owning 51.4% of the SNP market. The state wasn't involved in a dual demonstration.
