1. MEDICARE OVERVIEW FOR SOUTH DAKOTA (UPDATED 3-12-21)

South Dakota Medicare enrollment was about 181,000 in 2020, with about 42,000 enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan. About 11% of the state's total Medicare populations is comprised of individuals with disabilities. South Dakota wasn't involved in a dual demonstration. However, the state had 282 Special Needs Plan members as of November 2020.

2. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN FINANCIALS

Medicare Advantage plans in South Dakota generated total premiums of \$245 million in 2019 and medical costs of \$205 million. Average MLR was 83.7% after reinsurance recoveries.

(Note: Financial metrics and comparisons presented in this overview are based on health plan NAIC filings in the state. Measures like per member per month premiums and medical loss ratios may vary greatly by plan and by state depending on the mix of business and other factors.)

4. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN PREMIUMS, DEDUCTIBLES, STAR RATINGS

South Dakota's top five Medicare Advantage plans had STAR ratings of 3.5 to 4.5 in 2020. Maximum premium ranged from \$0 per month at CVS Health to \$240 at Medica.

5. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE ENROLLMENT UPDATE

There were about 181,000 Medicare members in South Dakota in 2020, up 1.9% from 2019. Traditional Medicare accounted for more than half of the total at 76.8%; however, its share is declining. Medicare Advantage enrollment accounted for 23.2% of the total at about 42,000, an 11.8% increase in 2020 compared to year-end 2019. Excluding Prescription Drug Plan and 800 Series enrollment, Medicare Advantage members rose 12.3% to 38,176 in 2020.

Medica is the largest Medicare Advantage plan in the state, followed by Humana and CVS Health.
