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1. MEDICARE OVERVIEW FOR UTAH (UPDATED 3-12-21)

Utah Medicare enrollment was close to 418,000 in 2020, with about 170,000 enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan. About 12% of the state's total Medicare population is comprised of individuals with disabilities. Utah was not involved in the federal Financial Alignment Initiative for Medicare-Medicaid Enrollees. However, the state had 8,324 Special Needs Plan members as of November 2020.

2. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN FINANCIALS

Medicare Advantage plans in Utah generated total premiums of nearly \$1.6 billion in 2019 and medical costs of \$1.3 billion. Average MLR was 85.0% after reinsurance recoveries.

(Note: Financial metrics and comparisons presented in this overview are based on health plan NAIC filings in the state. Measures like per member per month premiums and medical loss ratios may vary greatly by plan and by state depending on the mix of business and other factors.)

4. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE PLAN PREMIUMS, DEDUCTIBLES, STAR RATINGS

Utah's top five Medicare Advantage plans had STAR ratings of 3.5 to 4.5 in 2020. Maximum premium ranged from \$33 per month at Humana to \$72 at Intermountain Health Care.

5. MEDICARE ADVANTAGE ENROLLMENT UPDATE

There were nearly 418,000 Medicare members in Utah in 2020, up 2.8% from 2019. Traditional Medicare accounted for more than half of the total at 59.4%; however, its share is declining. Medicare Advantage enrollment accounted for 40.6% of the total at about 170,000, an 11.3% increase in 2020 compared to year-end 2019. Excluding Prescription Drug Plan and 800 Series enrollment, Medicare Advantage members rose 11.4% to 161,544 in 2020.

UnitedHealth Group is the largest Medicare Advantage plan in the state, followed by Intermountain Health Care and CVS Health.

6. SNPs AND DUAL ELIGIBLES

Utah had a total of 8,324 Special Needs Plan members as of November 2020, of which 7,937 were dual eligibles. Molina Healthcare controlled nearly 90% of the SNP market. The state wasn't involved in a dual demonstration.
