#### **Iowa**

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### 1. MANAGED CARE OPPORTUNITY ASSESSMENT (UPDATED 10-06-23)

Iowa awarded incumbent Anthem/Amerigroup and non-incumbent Molina Healthcare Medicaid managed care contracts for Iowa Health Link Medicaid managed care program, consisting of traditional Medicaid, Iowa Health and Wellness Plan, and Children's Health Insurance Program (known as Healthy and Well Kids in Iowa (Hawki). Contracts began on July 1, 2023. Incumbent Centene/Iowa Total Care will continue to serve the Medicaid population but did not need to participate in the RFP process because it holds a contract through 2025.

Overall, Iowa's implementation of Medicaid managed care has been a bumpy ride. The program, called IA Health Link, took effect in April 2016, with three health plans winning contracts to serve about 600,000 Medicaid members: AmeriHealth Caritas, Anthem and UnitedHealthcare of the River Valley. Plans experienced heavy financial losses, leading AmeriHealth to exit the program in 2017 and UnitedHealthcare to exit in 2019. Another plan Centene/Iowa Total Care joined the program in 2019. The state evenly distributed UnitedHealthcare's 600,000 members between Anthem/Amerigroup and Centene.

Iowa implemented a two-part alternative Medicaid expansion in December 2013. Under the original expansion, adults below 100% of poverty were eligible for the Iowa Health and Wellness Plan, a Medicaid managed care offering, while adults from 101% to 138% could choose an Exchange plan. In April 2016, Iowa moved all expansion members into the Iowa Health and Wellness Plan and implemented mandatory managed care through existing plans Centene and Anthem/Amerigroup.

#### 2. MANAGED MEDICAID PLAN FINANCIALS

Average MLR among Medicaid MCOs in Iowa was 90.9% in 2022. The average PMPM premium was \$660.08.

(Note: Financial metrics and comparisons presented in this overview are based on health plan NAIC filings in the state. Measures like per member per month premiums and medical loss ratios may vary greatly by plan and by state depending on the mix of business (e.g., TANF, ABD, etc.), scope of the state's Medicaid benefit package, geographic variations in the cost of care, and other factors.)

#### 3. RFP DEVELOPMENTS AND ANALYSIS (UPDATED 10-06-23)

Iowa awarded incumbent Anthem/Amerigroup and non-incumbent Molina Healthcare Medicaid managed care contracts for Iowa Health Link Medicaid managed care program, consisting of traditional Medicaid, Iowa Health and Wellness Plan, and Children's Health Insurance Program (known as Healthy and Well Kids in Iowa (Hawki). Contracts for began on July 1, 2023. Incumbent Centene/Iowa Total Care will continue to serve the Medicaid population but did not need to participate in the RFP process because it holds a contract through 2025.

Iowa released an RFP in November 2023 to procure a Quality Improvement Organization (QIO) vendor for the Iowa Medicaid program. Iowa will award one contract to operate for two years, with the option for four one-year contract extensions. Proposals are due February 5, 2024, with awards expected on March 29, 2024. The anticipated contract start date is July 1, 2024. The current QIO is Telligen.

In October 2017, Iowa issued an RFP to add one or more Medicaid managed care organizations after it was confirmed that AmeriHealth Caritas Iowa, would be exiting the program. In May 2018, the Iowa Department of Human Services issued a Medicaid managed care contract to Iowa Total Care, Inc., a subsidiary of Centene. In July 2019, UnitedHealthcare of the River Valley exited the market as well. The state evenly distributed UnitedHealthcare's 600,000 members between Anthem/Amerigroup and Centene.

The state announced four winners of its initial Medicaid managed care RFP in 2015: Anthem/Amerigroup, AmeriHealth Caritas, UnitedHealthcare Plan of the River Valley, and WellCare. However, the state's Department of Administrative Services issued an order to remove WellCare from the program, citing a lack of certain disclosures. WellCare contested the decision but lost its appeal. Meridian, Aetna, and Iowa Total Care were not listed among the winners and have appealed the awards. After a brief delay over provider network concerns, the program was implemented in April 2016.

In conjunction with the RFP, services provided by Magellan in two separate behavioral health contracts were carved into the Medicaid managed care contract in January 2016. The two contracts (Iowa Medicaid Contract and Iowa Medicaid Integrated Health Home Provider Agreement) generated net revenues for Magellan of \$465 million in 2014.



## 5. MEDICAID FEE FOR SERVICE VS. MANAGED CARE PENETRATION

Total Medicaid enrollment in Iowa was 850,906 in 2022. About 95.7% of Medicaid beneficiaries were enrolled in a managed care plan. The remainder are in fee-for-service Medicaid. Total Medicaid expenditures were \$6.6 billion in 2022, with about 98.8% through managed care and the rest through fee-for-service.
